



Sensor Hub Workshop: Sensor & Sensor Applications Development with Government Departments

Nowadays, sensor plays an important role in our everyday life and in IoT. HKSTP has launched the Sensor Hub program that enables sensor product developers/technology companies to test their sensors in real environment. Through the sensor hub program, the users can conduct the testing and tuning of their sensors before placing them to real applications, and the users can also collect and validate the sensor data for further product development.

Electrical and Mechanical Services Department (EMSD), HKSAR Government will install the infrastructure of LoRa network in Science Park that facilitates the testing of new sensor solutions. This workshop aims to provide the match opportunities between EMSD and park companies to develop and test the new sensor solutions/devices that would be potentially used by Government Departments.
